## **CMAC China Training and Heritage Trip 2011**

### **Notice of Meeting and Disclosure**

A meeting has been organized at CMAC Mississauga on May 7th @ 4pm for CMAC students and members interested in participating in the CMAC China Heritage Trip 2011.

THIS IS A CMAC TRIP AND IS FOR CMAC MEMEBRS ONLY. If you or some one you know wishes to attend this trip a CMAC membership can be acquired through any CMAC affiliate school. All members must be a registered student or personally know one and must be traveling with an up to date registered martial arts student of Classical Martial Arts Canada who is over the age of eighteen.

Topics to be covered will include:

- The nature and purpose of the trip i.e. – this is not a vacation
- Itinerary and what it includes
- Accommodations
- Fights and local transportation
- Etiquette ( this is a CMAC event )
- Policies and safety
- Identity protection
- Necessitates - i.e., clothing, foot where, and other gear required and not required.
- Currency and banking abroad
- Medical insurances, comprehensive and liabilities
- Travel documentation and other securities
- Personal responsibilities i.e, any and all belongings, purchases and luggage
- Training, education and content

\*Please read the statement below before deciding to attend the meeting\*:

New Century has put together a great trip that has been split up into three parts to allow access to those who wish to participate but may or may not be able to commit to the whole trip. Absolutely no custom access to the trip will be allowed outside the itinerary provisions New Century has allowed for. Interested students and members need to understand that they MUST choose to participate based exclusively on the options made available in the final itinerary posted at [www.cmacdapo.com/china](http://www.cmacdapo.com/china). There will be no amendments or extensions made or offered once the trip has commenced. If an attendee shows up in China and has not prepaid in full for the trip, they will not be allowed to join the group, period, no exceptions and no arrangements will be made, THEY WILL BE ON THEIR OWN. Those who wish to participate must have their minimum 50% deposit in to New Century by the due date (MAY 17), no exceptions. If you are ill, injured, or temporarily limited in any other way, get a friend or family member to carry out the deposit for you. All final payments must be made, along with any outstanding debt owed to New Century, by the due date; any unsettled debt will result in that student's exclusion from this trip, no exceptions made outside of

FULL PAYMENT. The final date for full settlement is August 1 (unless paying by cash, debit, or certified cheque, for which the due date is October 1), again, no exceptions. New Century or CMAC will not refund those who have paid New Century for their trip, in full or in part, in the event of illness, schedule issues or other. This is a CMAC trip, and as such, it is expected that members keep their word, act professionally, and follow through, or have secured adequate insurance beforehand. All those attending must be sure they are in before committing. It is recommended that all students attending secure travel and trip cancellation insurance to protect themselves and their investment. All attendees must be minimum eighteen years old--absolutely no dependent children allowed--this will be strictly enforced. Do not contact CMAC Mississauga directly; please direct any inquiries to the respective Director of the school you train at or registered your CMAC membership with.

Remember, this is a professional trip being provided in affiliation with Classical Martial Arts of Canada, and as such all attendees are expected to act in a manner that exemplifies the organizational banner they will be traveling under. It is expected that all who attend understand that we are going to a foreign country as Canadians and must act in a diplomatic fashion in accordance with the image and impression we wish to make and leave behind.
